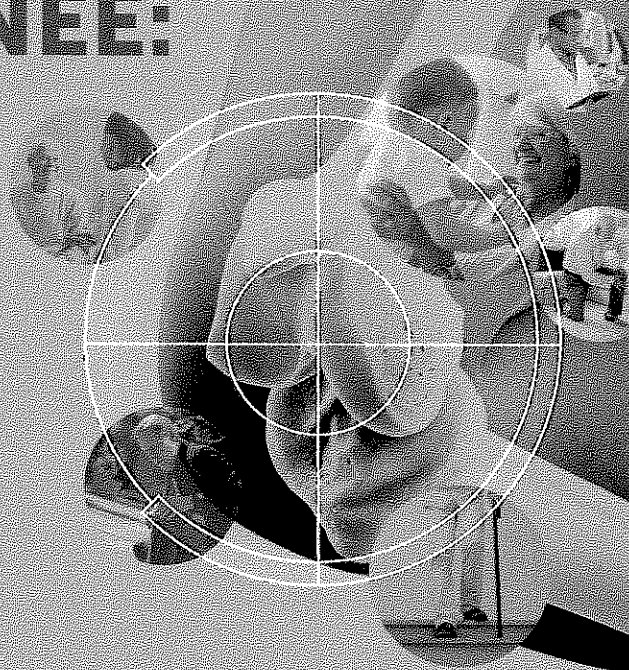


# OSTEOARTHRITIS OF THE KNEE:



## TOGETHER WE MAY BE ABLE TO FIND A TARGETED THERAPY FOR OA.

### We're studying a targeted therapy that may help you and others like you with osteoarthritis of the knee.

Osteoarthritis (OA) of the knee can be an extremely painful condition. Currently available treatment options can have limitations. The GOAL Study will check whether a patch that contains a pain medication (a study drug patch) works and is safe for people with OA of the knee. The study drug patch sticks to the knee and delivers the pain medication through the skin.

The study drug patch will be compared with a patch that does not contain any pain medication (a placebo patch). You will be assigned by chance to use either the study drug patch or the placebo patch (collectively referred to as the "study patch") during the study.

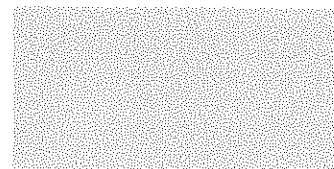
You or someone you care for may be able to take part if you/they:

- are 40–85 years of age
- have been diagnosed with OA of the knee
- are experiencing knee pain caused by OA.

If you take part, you will be in the study for about 17 weeks. You will apply the study patch to your knee every day for 12 weeks. You will visit the study center 8 times and have 4 telephone calls for study assessments.
